Proposed <u>SB-340</u> AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR HOUSING SERVICES.

Proposed <u>SB-344</u> AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE COUNCIL.

Proposed <u>SB-355</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A LANDLORD'S ABILITY TO REVIEW CRIMINAL RECORDS RELATING TO A PROSPECTIVE TENANT.

Proposed <u>SB-385</u> AN ACT REQUIRING ALL STATE AGENCIES TO INCLUDE CERTAIN QUESTIONS RELATING TO VETERAN STATUS ON STATE FORMS.

Proposed <u>SB-395</u> AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR TELEHEALTH.

Proposed <u>SB-396</u> AN ACT ALLOWING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO TRACK AND TRACE CELLULAR PHONES OF YOUNG ADULTS IN DISTRESS.

Proposed <u>SB-557</u> AN ACT CONCERNING STAFFING NEEDS IN MENTAL HEALTH CARE.

Proposed <u>SB-572</u> AN ACT CONCERNING COMMUNITY CRISIS RESPONSE TEAMS AND REENTRY CENTERS.

Proposed <u>SB-574</u> AN ACT REVISING PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC ACT 20-1 OF THE JULY SPECIAL SESSION, ALSO KNOWN AS THE POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY ACT.

Proposed <u>SB-600</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE BUS PASSES FOR PERSONS WHO ARE HOMELESS.

Proposed <u>SB-659</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN OPIOID RECOVERY AND REFORM PILOT PROGRAM.

Proposed <u>SB-668</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A FAIR WORK WEEK SCHEDULE.

Proposed <u>SB-679</u> AN ACT PROHIBITING SMOKING AT CERTAIN PRIVATE, NONPROFIT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FACILITIES.
