Legislative Update # 7

February 8, 2021

The Public Safety Committee will hold a hearing on February 11, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. Testimony can be provided via Zoom and in writing. Bills to be heard that may be of interest to the behavioral health community include the following:

Proposed <u>HB-5723</u> AN ACT CONCERNING POLICE DEPARTMENT ACCESS TO OPIOID ANTAGONISTS SUCH AS NARCAN.

Proposed <u>SB-781</u> AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE STATE POLICE ACADEMY AND POLICE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL.

<u>HB-5078</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF TECHNOLOGY THAT POLICE OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL MAY USE WHEN RESPONDING TO OPIOID OVERDOSES.

HB-5162 AN ACT CREATING A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE, THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES AND MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES REGARDING CARE OF PEOPLE ADDICTED TO OPIOIDS.

<u>HB-5586</u> AN ACT REQUIRING EXPANSION OF THE CRISIS INITIATIVE PILOT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

<u>SB-385</u> AN ACT REQUIRING ALL STATE AGENCIES TO INCLUDE CERTAIN QUESTIONS RELATING TO VETERAN STATUS ON STATE FORMS.

<u>SB-572</u> AN ACT CONCERNING COMMUNITY CRISIS RESPONSE TEAMS AND REENTRY CENTERS.

Proposed <u>HB-5599</u> AN ACT REMOVING OBSTACLES TO RENTAL RELIEF FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

Proposed <u>HB-5601</u> AN ACT INCREASING FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY NONPROFIT PROVIDERS.

Proposed <u>HB-5649</u> AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE NONPROFIT GRANT PROGRAM.

Proposed <u>HB-5654</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE UPDATING OF STATE FORMS, APPLICATIONS AND METHODS OF IDENTIFICATION TO INCLUDE A NONBINARY GENDER OPTION.

Proposed <u>HB-5663</u> AN ACT WAIVING RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA LICENSING FEES FOR CERTAIN PERSONS.

Proposed <u>HB-5664</u> AN ACT ALLOWING MEDICAL MARIJUANA PATIENTS TO GROW A LIMITED NUMBER OF MARIJUANA PLANTS.

Proposed <u>HB-5677</u> AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID VIOLENCE PREVENTATIVE SERVICES.

Proposed <u>HB-5699</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION PILOT PROGRAM.

Proposed <u>HB-5716</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSURE OF ART THERAPISTS.

Proposed <u>HB-5717</u> AN ACT CONCERNING DISABILITY COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEDICAL AND DENTAL LICENSURE.

Raised <u>HB-6398</u> AN ACT CONCERNING VARIOUS REVISIONS TO STATUTES CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES.

Proposed <u>SB-706</u> AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION ORGANIZATIONS.

Proposed <u>SB-754</u> AN ACT AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS TO PROVIDE STATE SERVICES.

Proposed <u>SB-779</u> AN ACT AUTHORIZING SPORTS WAGERING, ONLINE GAMING, ONLINE LOTTERY TICKET SALES AND ONLINE KENO IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT.

Proposed <u>SB-780</u> AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY CERTIFICATES ISSUED BY PHYSICIANS AND FIREARM POSSESSION AND SALES.
