Legislative Update #8

February 9, 2021

Tomorrow, February 10, 2021, Governor Lamont will make public his proposed budget for the next two state fiscal years. I will work to provide information on how the budget impacts the behavioral health community as soon as we have unpacked it.

The Appropriations Committee will hold the DMHAS budget presentation on Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at 2:30 p.m., via Zoom. The hearing for the public to testify on the DMHAS budget will be on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. Individuals wishing to sign up to testify will need to access the Bulletin notices for the public hearing which will include links to an online registration form for the public hearing. The state agency presentations and hearing can be viewed via YouTube Live and the public hearing may recorded and broadcast live on CT-N.com. Individuals can submit public testimony on the DMHAS budget by sending it via email to phtestimony@cga.ct.gov.

Several bills to increase funding to non-profit providers, including those serving the behavioral health community, have been proposed. These bills are proposed <u>HB-5743</u>, <u>HB-5744</u>, <u>HB-5747</u>, <u>HB-5751</u>, <u>HB-5866</u>, and <u>HB-6357</u>
