



Bonding Subcommittee Agency Presentation



The General Obligation Bonding Subcommittee held a hearing on the Governor's proposed capital budget. Commissioner Navarretta went in front of the Subcommittee to answer questions legislators may have pertaining to the bonding requests related to DMHAS.

What Else Took Place at the LOB?

Some committees are holding their last public hearings of the session, while other committees have met their Joint Favorable Deadline where they can no longer vote any bills out of committee. This week, some of the committees that have approached their JF deadline are: Human Services Committee, Commerce Committee, Government Oversight Committee, and more!

Did You Know?

Once a bill gets voted out of committee, the Committee Clerk must provide a report known as the Joint Favorable Report. This report summarizes public hearing testimony and lists organizations that support and oppose the bill. Legislators tend to use JF Report as a way to get a general overview on how the public weighed in on certain bills. Members of the public can also view the report on the CGA website as well!
