- Today, the Public Health Committee raised more concepts. Watch [here](#).


Did You Know?

Legislative committees have certain deadlines to act upon bills.

The “*Proposed Bill*” deadline – the date in which individual legislators can submit ideas for bills in undrafted form – has already passed.

For these bills, committees can either vote to have proposed bills fully drafted in order to be considered at a public hearing – called a “*Committee Bill*” – or keep them in concept form to have a “subject matter public hearing”.

If actions aren’t taken by the committee bill deadline dates, the proposed bills do not move forward. See future issues for more information about Raised Bills and Subject Matter Public Hearings!
