## SHORT TERM GOALS MET

Number of STMAD collaboration increase by **160%**.

parents who report that they have set rules and clear expectations about drinking techniques exceeds and drug use.

An 30% increase in Number of Danbury Police officers trained in proper party dispersal target goal of 10.

## LONG TERM GOALS MET

30 day use rates among high school youth decreased 27% from 2010 to 2019.

Binge drinking rates among high school youth decreased 35% from 2010 to 2019.

High school youth who report parent disapproval of alcohol use has increased 18% from 2010 to 2019.
