QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Question: Can you please expand upon the criteria for a number of people served? Might this include one contact for harm reduction? Supplies or a session for a peer support contact for example.

Answer: Engagements at Harm Reduction Centers as it relates to people served are typically tracked by counting total number of visits in a reporting period (which includes repeat visits from the same person) and total unique individuals who visited in a reporting period. Within the context of a visit, other key interventions are tracked and reported such as connection to care or distribution of naloxone or other harm reduction supplies.

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
