The Finance, Revenue and Bonding Committee has jurisdiction over all matters relating to finance, revenue, capital bonding, fees, and taxation. Similar to the Appropriations Committee subcommittee structure, the FRB Committee has two subcommittees related to bonding:

- General Obligation Bonding Subcommittee focuses primarily on the General Bonding portion of the state budget.
- Transportation Bonding Subcommittee focuses on Bonding in the state budget for Transportation purposes.
