

Certified Peer Support & Recovery Professional (CPSRP)
Pilot Exam Questions

1. Where do you sign up for the exam?

The Connecticut Certification Board (CCB) will provide the information once the application has been processed and is complete.

2. It was stated that the test is Time Limited. How much time is that?

The length of time for the pilot exam will be determined by the psychometrician.
Time-limited referred to the grandparenting process window to take the pilot exam.

3. How much time should I expect to put aside to take the exam?

The length of time will be determined by the psychometrician.

4. If you are certified already through Advocacy Unlimited, do you have to retake the exam?

The Certified Peer Support & Recovery Professional (CPSRP) is the state's new peer credential. If you choose to obtain the credential, you need to complete the grandparenting process. That does include taking the pilot exam. The pilot exam is an automatic Pass.

5. Is the exam pass/fail, and do I have to take it again if I fail?

The pilot exam is an automatic pass.

6. Is the exam in person or virtual?

The pilot exam is computer-based through the psychometrician.

7. It was stated that all applicants must sit for the exam by May 15th, but the deadline is June 30th. This is unclear.

The pilot exam is available until May 15th. Everyone grandparenting in, except for people going through a training in a DMHAS-approved Peer Training Organization between May 1st and June 30th, need to take the pilot exam.

8. Will we find out how we did on the exam?

The pilot exam is an automatic pass. They are not being individually scored.

9. What happens if we miss the exam deadline?

Applications should be submitted by April 15th to give enough time for processing.

10. How will you safeguard information supplied during the application process and beta testing?

The application was developed in Qualtrics software. Qualtrics software has secure data protection and confidentiality regulations installed. Prometric LLC is a licensed psychometrician and as a developer of credentialing examinations, their software is secure.

11. Why is the timeframe for the beta test so short?

People who qualify for the grandparenting process are being given two (2) months to complete the process. The application has very few requirements to meet.

12. Is the exam graded?

No. Because it is a pilot exam, it is an automatic pass.
