

## Opioid Settlement Fund Update for OSAC March 11, 2025

## **Budget Update**

As of 1/14/25, the State has received a total of \$158,299,575, with funding recommendations having passed for \$91,279,158 leaving a balance in the fund of \$67,020,417.

The estimated annual budget is \$33,333,333 and, to date, the estimated approved recommendations amount is \$28,738,203.

Today, the OSAC is considering one recommendation with a total of \$2,160,000.
