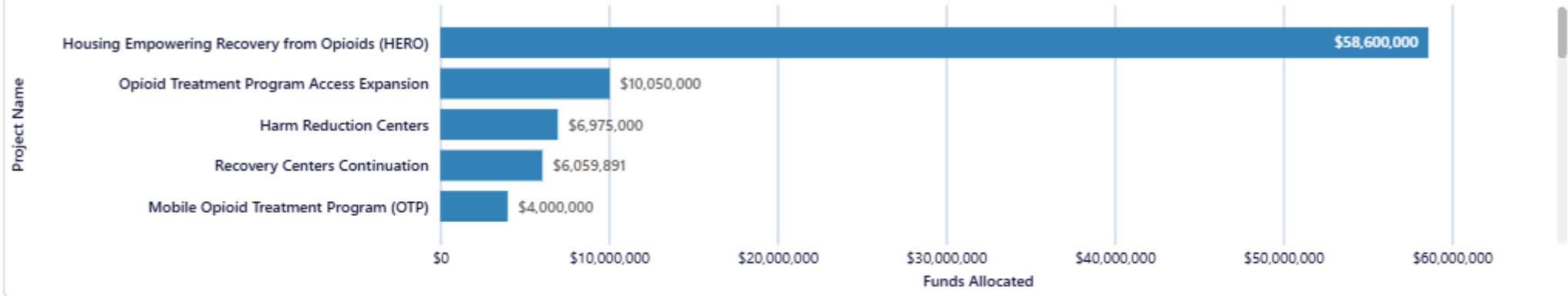
Connecticut Opioid Settlement Dashboard

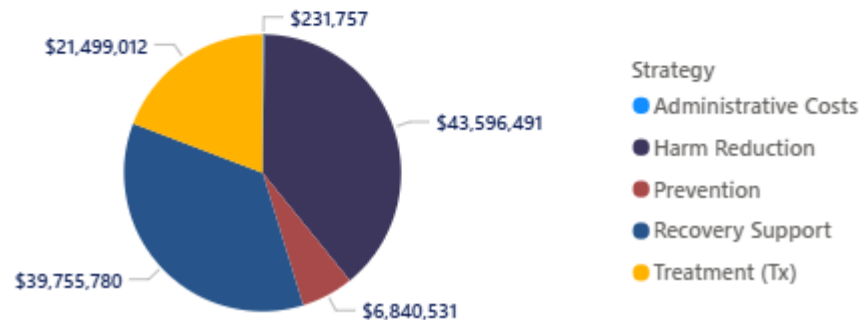

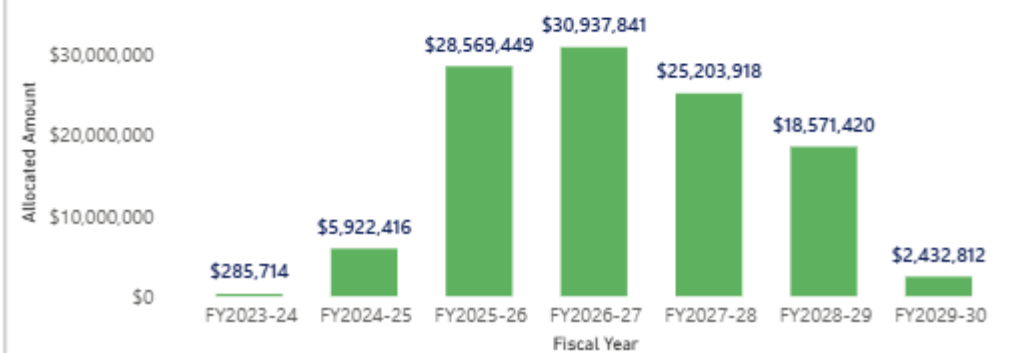
Funds Allocated by Project

Budget Update

- Total amount received in OSAC fund to date: \$185,886,363
 - Recent settlement payments received from Allergan, CVS, McKesson & Distributors, and Teva totaling approximately \$24 million
- Total amount of funding approved by OSAC to date: \$111,691,813
- Continuation funding requests today:
 - Naloxone Saturation Continuation: \$2,323,200 annually 3 for years=
\$6,969,600
 - LiveLOUD Public Awareness & Education Continuation: \$300,000 for 1 year
 - Anticipated new total of approved funding: 118,961,413
- Estimated cost of continuation of current projects through FY 29: \$140,844,034
- Estimated cost of continuation of current projects through FY 30: \$169,209,632

OTP Expansion:

- Contracts executed with participating providers
- Collecting baseline data and beginning implementation

HERO:

- Pre-screener Submitted: 544
 - Eligible Applicants thus far: 245
 - RAP Applications Submitted: 245
 - RAP Applications Approved: 135
 - Of these 135 individuals, 93 received the voucher and are actively seeking housing
 - Individuals Housed: 3

Public Input on Funding Initiatives

- Updated report published 3/3/26
- As of 2/22/2026, a total of 200 recommendations were received since October 2023
- Each of these recommendations were reviewed by the OSAC Referral Subcommittee and/or Subject Matter Experts and categorized as follows:
 - 34 recommendations were at least partially utilized for proposal development and approved by OSAC for implementation
 - 74 recommendations may be considered for future project development. It cannot be determined if or when associated projects will move forward. This designation is not a promise of project approval or funding.
 - 92 recommendations were not recommended to move forward for additional consideration
- Currently, OSAC has approved 21 projects totaling \$111,691,813
