

TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

SMILE YOU ARE ON CAMERA

For your safety this vehicle is being recorded both inside & out.

By entering the vehicle, you are giving consent to be recorded. The audio and video recordings are used strictly for safety purposes and will not otherwise be shared/published.



PERSONAL BELONGINGS

All personal belongings (except for cellphone or reading material) must fit in two bags and will be stored in the vehicle's trunk. The following items are never permitted in the vehicle or treatment units and must not be brought into the vehicle:

- Food or Drinks
- Alcohol or Drugs
- Weapons of any kind



BUCKLE UP

Seatbelts must be kept on at all times and passengers should follow any safety instructions provided by the driver.

NO STOPS

This vehicle cannot make stops at any time while enroute to your destination.
