#### MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 25, 2013 Hartford Regional Market 101 Reserve Road, Hartford, CT 06114

### I. CALL TO ORDER

IV. INTRODUCTION OF WORKING GROUP ASSIGNMENT

Chairman Oechsler introduced the assignment the Farm-to-Institution subgroups C will be undertaking in 2013, which is to examine state statute (CGS Sec. 22-38b(d)) regarding "Certified Farm Fresh Restaurants" and make recommendations for implementation of a workable program.

- V. DEVELOPMENT OF DRAFT DELIVERABLES The group engaged in an in-depth discussion about its assignment and came to consensus that it would make recommendations regarding relative state statutes and develop criteria for a tiered Connecticut Farm-to-Chef restaurant certification program in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture's existing Farm-to-Chef program and advisory team.
- VI. DETERMINATION OF RESOURCES REQUIRED The group discussed various ideas for funding the staff and materials required to implement and administer such a certification program.
- VII. RECAP AND NEXT STEPS

Chairman Oechsler recapped discussion highlights and next steps, which include group members reviewing additional statutory language, developing proposed recommendations regarding that language, and working with the Farm-to-Chef advisory team to develop certification program requirements.

There was no further business and Chairman Oechsler adjourned meeting at 3:10 p.m.
