

^{*} The <u>Department's CGAP program</u> is voluntary food safety audit program for produce growers. CGAP builds on the FDA Produce Safety Rule and adds additional requirements for records, a recall program and training programs designed to enhance the food safety culture on the produce farm. After a successful audit by DoAg auditors, CGAP participants are provided a certificate they can provide to their wholesale customers that verifies their status in the CGAP program.



^{*}Qualified End Users are either: (1) The consumer of the food or (2) a restaurant or retail food establishment that is located in the same State or the same Indian reservation as the farm or not more than 275 miles away
