WHEREAS, the Banking Commissioner ("Commissioner") is charged with the administration of Part II of Chapter 668, Sections 36a-535 to 36a-547, inclusive, of the Connecticut General Statutes, "Finance Companies";

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto is a Connecticut limited liability company with its main office at 10 Frontage Road, East Haven, Connecticut;

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto has never been licensed to engage in the business of a sales finance company in Connecticut;

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2024, Peoples Auto submitted an application through the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System and Registry ("NMLS") for a license to engage in the business of a sales finance company in Connecticut, which is currently pending;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner, through the Consumer Credit Division of the Department of Banking, conducted an investigation pursuant to Section 36a-17(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes into the activities of Peoples Auto to determine if it had violated, was violating or was about to violate the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes within the jurisdiction of the Commissioner;

WHEREAS, as a result of such investigation, the Commissioner alleges that since July 2023, Peoples Auto engaged in the business of a sales finance company in Connecticut without a sales finance company license, in violation of Section 36a-536 of the Connecticut General Statutes;

WHEREAS, there have been no Connecticut consumer complaints reported against Peoples Auto;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner believes that such allegation would support initiation of enforcement proceedings against Peoples Auto, including, without limitation, proceedings to issue an order to cease and desist against Peoples Auto pursuant to Sections 36a-543(d) and 36a-52(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes and impose a civil penalty of up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) per violation upon Peoples Auto pursuant to Sections 36a-543(d) and 36a-50(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes;

WHEREAS, initiation of such enforcement proceedings would constitute a "contested case" within the meaning of Section 4-166(2) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Section 4-177(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 36a-1-55(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies provide that a contested case may be resolved by consent order, unless precluded by law;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner and Peoples Auto acknowledge the possible consequences of formal administrative proceedings, and Peoples Auto voluntarily agrees to consent to the entry of the sanctions imposed below without admitting or denying any allegation set forth herein, and solely for the purpose of obviating the need for further formal administrative proceedings concerning the allegation contained herein;

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto acknowledges that it has had the opportunity to consult with and be represented by independent counsel in negotiating and reviewing this Consent Order and executes this Consent Order freely;

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto acknowledges that this Consent Order is a public record and is a reportable event for purposes of NMLS, as applicable;

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto herein represents to the Commissioner that it has reviewed and updated its internal policies, procedures and controls for ensuring compliance with sales finance company licensure requirements in Connecticut;

AND WHEREAS, Peoples Auto, through its execution of this Consent Order, voluntarily agrees to waive its procedural rights, including a right to a notice and an opportunity for a hearing as it pertains to the allegation set forth herein, and voluntarily waives its right to seek judicial review or otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order.

CONSENT TO ENTRY OF SANCTIONS

WHEREAS, Peoples Auto, through its execution of this Consent Order, consents to the Commissioner's entry of a Consent Order imposing the following sanctions:

- 1. No later than the date this Consent Order is executed by Peoples Auto, it shall remit to the Department of Banking by electronic funds transfer, cashier's check, certified check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut", the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) as a civil penalty;
- 2. No later than the date this Consent Order is executed by Peoples Auto, it shall remit to the Department of Banking by electronic funds transfer, cashier's check, certified check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut", the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) for back licensing fees; and
- 3. Peoples Auto shall cease and desist from engaging in the business of a sales finance company in Connecticut without a license, in violation of Section 36a-536 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

CONSENT ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioner enters the following:

- 1. The Sanctions set forth above be and are hereby entered;
- 2. Upon issuance of this Consent Order by the Commissioner, this matter will be resolved and the Commissioner will not take any future enforcement action against Peoples Auto based upon the allegation contained herein; provided that issuance of this Consent Order is without prejudice to the right of the Commissioner to take enforcement action against Peoples Auto based upon a violation of this Consent Order or the matters underlying its entry, if the Commissioner determines that compliance with the terms herein is not being observed or if any representation made by Peoples Auto and reflected herein is subsequently discovered to be untrue;
- 3. Peoples Auto shall not take any action or make or permit to be made any public statement, including in regulatory filings, any proceeding in any forum or otherwise, denying, directly or

indirectly, any allegation referenced in this Consent Order or create the impression that this Consent Order is without factual basis. Except as specifically provided herein, Peoples Auto shall not take any position in any proceeding brought by or on behalf of the Commissioner, or to which the Commissioner is a party, that is inconsistent with any part of this Consent Order. Nothing in this provision affects Peoples Auto's (i) testimonial obligations, or (ii) right to take any legal or factual position that may contradict an allegation in this Consent Order in litigation or other legal proceedings in which the Commissioner is not a party;

- 4. Subject to the foregoing, and so long as this Consent Order is promptly disclosed by Peoples Auto and its control persons, as applicable, on NMLS, nothing in the issuance of this Consent Order shall adversely affect the ability of Peoples Auto to apply for or obtain an initial license or renewal licenses under Part II of Chapter 668, Sections 36a-535 et seq., of the Connecticut General Statutes, provided all applicable legal requirements for such license are satisfied and the terms of this Consent Order are followed;
- 5. This Consent Order shall be binding upon Peoples Auto and its successors and assigns; and
- `6. This Consent Order shall become final when issued.
