

APPLICATION & MORE:

The Application Portal Re-opens: August 15, 2025. Apply now - funds awarded on a first-come, firstserved basis!

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Connecticut Residency: Must have lived in CT for at least 5 consecutive years prior to application.
- Education: Graduated from a Connecticut public or private college or university with a degree or have earned an occupation/professional license or certificate.
- Income Limits: \$125,000 for single applicants and \$175,000 for married applicants
- Volunteer Service: Complete 50 hours at a registered 501(c)(3), in municipal government, through military service, or through required unpaid work as a student for certificate or degree program (notarized).
- Loan Payments: Made payments on qualifying student loan payments in 2024.
- Stone Academy: Applicants enrolled in the practical nurse education program at Stone Academy from November 1, 2021, through February 28, 2023, and did not complete the program may be eligible for SLRP.

HOW TO APPLY:

- STEP 1: GATHER ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS
 - 2023 Federal Income Tax Return.
 - Diploma, professional license or certification earned at a CT institution higher education.
 - Proof of 50 hours of volunteer service begun no earlier than January 2024 (notarized).
 - Student loan statement with borrower's name and loan account number and loan history showing individual payments made in 2024.
- STEP 2: SUBMIT APPLICATION ONLINE
 - Access the <u>CT Scholars</u> portal.
 - Upload documents and complete your application
- **STEP 3: CHECK STATUS**
 - Monitor your application process through the CT Scholars Portal.
