Administrative Directive Number: 9.6 Title: Inmate Administrative Remedies I recommend the following inclusion or revision to the above referenced Administrative Directive X (provide detailed explanation regarding reason for change): The following language is suggested to be added to Administrative Directive 9.6, Inmate Administrative Remedies section 5 subsection I, Time limitations. In the event of incapacitation or other emergent medical circumstances which i. preclude an inmate from having access to the Administrative Remedies procedure, the inmate must adhere to the time frames set forth in this Directive once these circumstances have improved sufficiently to allow the inmate to access the Administrative Remedies procedure. In such circumstances, the timeframes shall be thirty (30) days from the event that is the basis of the Administrative Remedy not including the period of time during which the inmate was incapacitated or otherwise prevented from accessing the Administrative Remedies procedures due to emergent medical circumstances. This language is suggested based on Rucker v.
