HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR DD214

You should be able to get a copy of your DD214 through the VA Home & Hospital in Rocky Hill, CT. Contact **Mike Gallow** at **(860) 529-2571 X2460**. If you were discharged after 1985, and had submitted a Connecticut address when you enlisted, chances are, they have a copy on file.

If they do not have a copy on file, Mr. Gallow can assist you in filling out a **Standard Form 180**, which needs to be submitted to the VA Central Records Processing Center in St. Louis, MO. Have the following information handy:

- Name
- Address
- Social Security Number
- Date of Birth
- Branch of Service you served in
- Approximate date of your discharge

Mr. Gallow will assist you in filing your paperwork online. You can expect a turn around time of two to four weeks to obtain your DD214.

Make sure to ask if you can get a Member-4 Copy of the DD214

You may also call the **Federal Veterans Affairs Office at 1-800-827-1000** to obtain assistance in obtaining your DD214.

There are instructions on-line how to submit the form. You can expect a turn around time of two to three months to obtain your DD214 by mailing in your request.
