**Death of Incarcerated Individual at the Osborn Correctional Institution  
Under Investigation**

For Immediate Release – May 21, 2026

**(SOMERS, CT)** — The Connecticut Department of Correction is investigating the death of an incarcerated individual at the Osborn correctional Institution.

At approximately 8:13 a.m. on May 21, 2026, a medical emergency code was called for an incarcerated individual who was in respiratory distress. He was housed in the Osborn Correctional Institution's infirmary at the time of the incident.

Responding staff immediately initiated emergency and life-saving measures.

Paramedics from a local ambulance company arrived at the scene to transport the individual to a nearby hospital. The individual was pronounced deceased at the hospital at 9:16 a.m.

The deceased individual is identified as 62-year-old Daniel Serrano of Bridgeport, CT. He most recently entered the Department of Correction system on July 3, 2025, and was serving a two-year sentence.

The Connecticut State Police and the Office of the Inspector General are investigating the death.

The exact cause of death will be determined by the State Medical Examiner's Office.
