



Death of Incarcerated Individual Housed at the Corrigan Correctional Center Under Investigation

For Immediate Release – June 11, 2026

(UNCASVILLE, CT) —The death of an incarcerated individual at the Corrigan Correctional Center is under investigation.

At approximately 1:00 p.m. on June 11, 2026, while conducting a routine tour, staff discovered an incarcerated individual unresponsive in his cell. He was the sole occupant of the cell.

Responding to the scene, correctional and medical staff immediately initiated live saving measures. Staff members continued to perform CPR until the arrival of a local ambulance company, which proceeded to transport the individual to an outside hospital for treatment.

Shortly after arriving at the hospital, the individual was pronounced deceased at 1:48 p.m.

The Connecticut State Police and the Office of the Inspector General are investigating the death.

The individual is being identified as 60-year-old Thomas Harrison of no known address. He last entered the Department of Correction system on June 1, 2026.

The exact cause of death will be determined by the State Medical Examiner's Office.
