### **NOTICE TO OFFENDER POPULATION**

Effective February 1, 2016 a new Class "A" Offense has been added to Administrative Directive 9.5, Code of Penal Discipline. The offense is: Refusal or Removal of an Institutional Program or Policy. The offense is defined as:

**Refusal or Removal of an Institutional Program or Policy.** Refusing to sign an Offender Accountability Plan, refusing to participate in or refusing to attend a recommended program listed on an Offender Accountability Plan or being removed from a recommended program due to lack of participation, lack of attendance, involved in a serious incident during the program or being continually disruptive while in the program. Refusing to submit a DNA sample or refusing to complete Sex Offender Registration.

- A guilty finding of the Class "A" Offense for Refusal or Removal of an Institutional Program will result in a mandatory forfeiture of 25 days of RREC.
