Checklist of Documents to Bring to Court After Release

After your release, if you are going to court regarding a child support order, you will need to bring the following documents, if you have them.

Income Verification

- → Thirteen weeks pay stubs
- → Unemployment verification
- → Financial affidavit
- → Inform support enforcement officer of other children you have living with you

Helpful Financial Information

- → Health insurance information cost for self and children
- → Court orders that affect your financial situation (alimony) and receipts to verify payment
- → Verification of union or other employment related dues
- → Special education costs
- → Daycare costs (receipts or letter from day care provider)

If You Have a Medical Condition

- → Medical bills
- → Doctor's letter stating medical condition
- → Doctor's letter for spouse stating medical condition
