Connecticut Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (CBCCEDP)

The CBCCEDP is a federal and state funded program that provides free screening and diagnostic services for uninsured and underinsured women in the state. Administered by the Department of Public Health (DPH), CBCCEDP serves to reduce breast and cervical cancer mortality by diagnosing these cancers at earlier stages.

Q. What services are available?

A. Free services include screening and diagnostic mammograms, Pap test, pelvic exams, clinical breast exams, breast biopsies, ultrasounds, fine needle aspirations, and colposcopies. Other activities supported by this program include community outreach, case management, tracking and follow-up of clients, professional education for providers, public education, and promotional activities to increase awareness of the benefits of early detection.

Q. Who is eligible?

A. For mammograms, women who are age 35-39 with risk factors and women who are 40 and over without risk factors; for Pap tests, women who are age 19 and over. All women must be at or below 200% of the federal poverty level and have no health insurance or health insurance that does not cover these services.

Q. Where are services available?

A. At any one the nineteen CBCCEDP provider sites located throughout the state (*see below*), women will be screened for eligibility, scheduled for an appointment, and receive screening and diagnostic services as needed.

Planned Parenthood of Connecticut (PPC)

PPC offers a wide range of reproductive health services for women and men of all ages. Services include all FDA-approved birth control methods (including Emergency Contraception), Pap tests and breast exams, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, HIV counseling and testing, female and male premarital blood testing, and pregnancy testing and counseling. PPC also offers medical and surgical abortion services. PPC in Bridgeport offers prenatal care. Most centers provide colposcopy and cyrosurgery. In addition, PPC operates a resource center in New Haven that is open to the public by appointment. The resource center has medically accurate, age appropriate and culturally competent videos, books, brochures and teaching materials addressing a variety of sexual topics.
