ORDINANCE #920 CITY OF SHELTON FAIR RENT COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SHELTON:

Establishment and Authority:

The City of Shelton hereby creates a Fair Rent Commission with full powers and authority as set forth in C.G.S. § 7-148b through 7-148f, §47a-20 and §47a-23c.

Membership and Terms:

The Commission shall be composed of five members appointed by the Board of Aldermen as follows: two members to serve for a term of two years and three members to serve for a term of one year. Upon the expiration of each member's term, members shall thereafter be appointed by the Board of Aldermen to terms of three years. Members shall be electors of the City and not more than three shall be of the same political party. There shall be one landlord member, one tenant member and three citizen members who are neither landlords nor tenants.

Officers:

At its initial meeting and at its first meeting on or after July 1st of each oddnumbered year, the Commission shall elect from its membership a Chairperson and a Vice Chairperson.
