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Subject: Emergency Broadband Benefits Program (EBB)

On behalf of the State of Connecticut, this notice provides information about the Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) program. The benefit provides a monthly \$50 credit toward each household's internet bill; a \$75 monthly discount for qualifying Tribal land households; and a one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer.

If prospective applicants are enrolled in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), the Free-and-Reduced-Price School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, Medicaid, Supplemental Security Income, Federal Public Housing Assistance, Veterans, and Survivors Pension Benefit, or experienced a significant loss of income in the past 16 months, they will likely qualify for this benefit. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment in the above programs or proof of income loss to be approved.

Interested parties can apply for the EBB program through the online portal ([linked here](#)), by mail using either of the following application forms ([English application](#); [Spanish application](#)), or by contacting their internet service provider ([participating providers found here](#)).
