**The State of Connecticut, Department of Housing is seeking public comment and will be holding PUBLIC HEARINGS on the DRAFT CDBG-DR National Disaster Resilience Competition Phase I Application.**

Please note the following **CORRECTION** on the **DATE** for the OPEN HOUSE and PUBLIC HEARING scheduled to take place in **NEW HAVEN**. **The PUBLIC HEARING scheduled for Kroon Hall, Yale University will take place on WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 18<sup>th</sup>, 2015**. This is a **DATE CORRECTION** from the original notice, and all other information remains the same.
