## THIRD REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION (AMENDED) GENERAL CONTRACTOR PREQUALIFICATION

## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – DISASTER RECOVERY

The State of Connecticut Department of Housing (DOH) is seeking proposals through a Request for Qualification (RFQ) process to prequalify General Contractors to be included in the list of approved contractors for the rehabilitation, reconstruction and/or mitigation of residential structures in compliance with all applicable local, federal, and state statutory requirements with special attention paid to requirements for Community Development Block Grants under the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") Disaster Recovery grant program for Hurricane Sandy. HUD initially allocated \$71.8 million dollars of funding and added \$66 million through a second tranche for to the State of Connecticut to assist with the recovery from Hurricane Sandy.

Construction projects include single and small multifamily housing projects damaged by Hurricane Sandy that are located in Fairfield, New Haven, New London or Middlesex Counties or in the Mashantucket-Pequot Reservation. Only General Contractors who respond to this RFQ and qualify will be considered for bidding on such projects.
