



## **State of Connecticut Division of Criminal Justice Unemployment Fraud Unit**



The Office of the Chief State's Attorney – Unemployment Compensation Fraud Unit arrested Bianca Davila, under the strength of an arrest warrant issued through the Bridgeport Superior Courthouse for Unemployment Fraud C.G.S. 31-273(f)(2), Larceny in the First Degree 53a-122(a)(4) – Defrauding a Public Community, Identity Theft 1<sup>st</sup> Degree 53a-129b, Identity Theft Second Degree 53a-129c, and Identity Theft 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree 53a-129d (5 counts). Davila is accused of collecting over \$20,000 in unemployment compensation, under the PII of her mother, Nancy Cruz, from July 2020 into 2021 and of stealing the identity of six other people. Davila was released on a \$60,000 court set surety bond. She was issued a, February 2, 2026, Bridgeport Superior Court date.
