The Office of the Chief State's Attorney – Unemployment Compensation Fraud Unit arrested Jesse Bennfield, under the strength of an arrest warrant issued through the New Britain Superior Courthouse for Unemployment Fraud C.G.S. 31-273(f)(2) and Larceny in the First Degree 53a-122(a)(4) – Defrauding a Public Community. Bennfield is accused of collecting \$56,319 in unemployment compensation, while at the same time earning \$139,175 in earned wages from Innovation Solutions, during claim weeks of June 6, 2020 to October 23, 2023. Bennfield was released on a \$25,000 non-surety bond and issued a March 4, 2024 New Britain Superior Court date.
