

CONNECT Digital Design Environment Revision Notification

CAD Resources - Update 04/28/2023

The Connecticut Department of Transportation's (CTDOT) Connect Digital Design Environment (DDE) is CTDOT's configuration/workspace for Bentley's Connect Edition software. The CTDOT Connect DDE contains resources, standards, and the tools necessary for designing projects in accordance with CTDOT CAD Standards. These resource files are continually updated as technology progresses, and Bentley releases new versions of their software applications.

This DDE release is configured to work with the following versions:

- OpenRoads Designer[™] 10.10.21.04
- OpenBridge Modeler[™] 10.10.20.92
- OpenBuildings Designer[™] 10.09.00.83

Users/consultants who have manually installed the previous versions of the CTDOT CONNECT DDE should now update their installation. CTDOT employees or consultants who are connected to SharePoint CTDOT CONNECT DDE do not need to update these files as this is done by AEC Applications.

The **updated Zip file dated 04/28/2023** can be downloaded from the CTDOT CONNECT DDE Website. There have not been any changes to the additional zip for OpenBuildings dated 09/01/2022 so this file will not need to be downloaded and re-installed at this time.

New WorkSet Properties

New WorkSet properties have been established for use with the Contract Border Title Block that suspends the need to connect up to projects in Bentley Cloud Services.

New projects and newly placed Borders will now read custom CTDOT Fields. Existing WorkSets created before the CTDOT Custom property fields were put into place can be manually added. Consultants using CTDOT COMPASS/SharePoint do not need to update anything as AEC Applications manages all WorkSets in SharePoint.

Future Release Information:

AEC Applications expects another release of the DDE to be available for download this Fall. This will include the 2023 schema change Bentley introduced this year to their Civil Applications (OpenRoads & OpenBridge). CTDOT finds it best to run all CAD applications on the same MicroStation version. At this point Bentley has not released a version of OpenBuilding's based on MicroStation CONNECT Edition 17 so our fall release may get pushed back until all applications are being run on the same base MS version.
