Post Construction Reviews (PCRs) – Updated Guidance

This Construction Directive provides enhanced guidance on submitting Post Construction Reviews (PCRs) for all projects.

An embedded email “button” has been added to the PCR form for your convenience. After completing the form, selecting the button will populate an email, with the filled out PCR form attached, to the above distribution list. The project staff should replace XXXX-XXXX in the subject line with their 8-digit project number prior to sending the email.

Why do we require submission of the PCR form?

Once provided by Construction staff and reviewed by OOC staff, PCRs are made available for use by Design, Construction and Maintenance to apply Lessons Learned from previous projects. It is an important part of the continuous improvement process for Construction project staff to provide in-depth feedback when they fill out the PCR form. The feedback provided often leads to improvements such as specification revisions, Design Manual revisions, Construction Manual revisions, and process changes.

Description of Changes:
