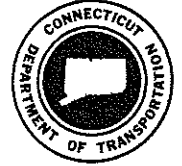

The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Certificate No. 1144, and are in violation of Connecticut General Statute Section 13b-96, as amended, by violating the terms of the certificate which requires the certificate holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically, the records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Sections of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

- 13b-96-4 Knowledge of Regulations
- 13b-96-13 Filing of Trade Name
- 13b-96-14 Business to be conducted under a single name
- 13b-96-16 Limits of operating authority
- 13b-96-17 Number of Taxicabs operated

Suburban Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Valley Cab registered a vehicle in an improper name with the Department of Motor Vehicles. The name used was not filed with the Department of Transportation or Secretary of State. The vehicle was operating in an area outside of Suburban Transportation's authorized territory.

Suburban Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Valley Cab, by operating the taxi (T4825T), exceeded the maximum vehicles the company is authorized under the Certificate No. 1144. Suburban Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Valley Cab operated in this manner for four (4) months.

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-96, as amended, **you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room A** on Tuesday, July 7, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this permit should not be revoked or suspended or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
