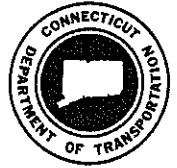

Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) Sections 13b-102, 13b-103, and 13b-106 as amended, by violating the terms of the Permit which requires the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.
