



**East Hartford and Willington
Design-Build Bridge Bundle along I-84 and Route 2
Biweekly Look-Ahead
Period of April 20, 2018 to May 4, 2018**



Throughout the week of April 23, 2018, The Middlesex Corporation, CTDOT's contractor for the Design-Build Bridge Bundle Project, will continue construction operations. Work will be performed project-wide during the standard working hours of 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

The closure of the Route 2 East ramp (connecting to Bridge 02369) is schedule to take place at 10:00 AM on Friday April 20th. Following the closure of the ramp, all traffic on Route 2 East intending to remain on Route 2 East towards Norwich and New London will use the Pitkin Street exit-ramp (Exit 3) and follow the detour route to Jayce Street in order to merge back onto Route 2 East. An officer from the Connecticut State Police will be on-site during these activities. A separate release containing detour information was published on March 29, 2018.

Work to reconstruction the shoulder on Route 2 East south of Bridge 02369 will begin the week of Monday, April 23rd. Concrete repairs and pier strengthening will continue throughout the week.

Work to set road barriers on Route 2 Eastbound, which began on Friday the 20th, will last through Monday April 23rd. This work will take place between the hours of. 9:00AM to 3:00PM.

At the end of the week of April 23rd, night work will take place to stripe lane markings on Bridge 02369 between the hours of 7:00 PM and 5:00 AM.

Phase 1 of the demolition of Bridge 02369 is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, May 1st, and will continue throughout the week.

Lane closures are necessary to create a safe work zone; drivers are asked to be aware of possible lane closures for their own safety and that of the project team. Please also note that all work is contingent upon the weather.
