Definition:

Earthfast: A method of construction in which the building structure is laid directly on the ground surface or set into the ground on posts, rather than resting on foundations.

Earthfast house with posts set into the ground.



Definition:

An artifact is any human-made or modified object or fragment of an object, such as a pottery sherd, gunflint, or nail.

Definition:

Ecofacts are organic materials associated with human activity, such as seeds.

Definition:

Features are manmade creations that are not portable, such as cellars, post holes, and foundation walls.

Definition:

A midden is a place where cultural material (such as trash or food remains) has been repeatedly deposited.
