DIVISIBLE LOAD PERMITS

Divisible Load Permits are issued to single-unit dump trucks and to tractor/trailer combination dump trucks specifically for the hauling of **BULK CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS** and **BULK PROCESSED AND RAW PRODUCTS** – see listing of Allowable Materials.

Divisible load permits are issued at the noted gross and axle weight limits to vehicles with the following axle configurations:
