

The bridge spans over:

- Bridgeport Harbor
- Route 130 (Stratford Ave.)
- Metro North Railroad
- Local roads
- High speed ferry terminal (currently in construction)
- No ROW involvement expected



Project Purpose & Need

The purpose of this project is to address observed deficiencies, maintain bridge 00111A in a state of good repair, meet current load rating standards, and extend the life of the structure while minimizing impacts to traffic on I-95 above and Bridgeport Harbor, Metro North, Route 130, and local roads below.





Summary of Recommendations

Bridge Rehabilitation and Fender Preservation:

- Strengthen girders and cross-frames as needed.
- Repair steel section losses ≥ 1/16" deep in critical areas.
- Field paint steel repair areas and other areas with advanced rust and/or section loss.
- Replace loose/missing structural bolts.
- Strip, Patch, Membrane, Overlay (SPMO)
- Replace all joints on the bridge in kind.
- Coat exposed reinforcing steel, deck delaminations and spalls on the underside of the concrete deck.
- Patch spalls in parapets and repair gaps in fence over Metro North Railroad.
- Replace missing junction box cover screws and repair damaged light poles, luminaire(s) and associated conduits.


- Drainage system rehabilitation:
 - Clean scuppers
 - Jet clean scupper pipes
 - Repair leaky week pipes
- Repair the fender system:
 - Fill voids in piles with non-shrink grout
 - Replace whales and planks
 - Replace deteriorated hardware
- Patch concrete substructure:
 - Including jacking girders to repair undermined bearings.
- Repair erosion along substructure units on land.





Maintenance & Protection of Traffic

- Three (3) lanes of through traffic and one (1) lane of ramp traffic during peak hours
- Underside work on the bridge requires temporary lane closures on local roads, partial parking area closures and pedestrian access restrictions.
 - Possible detour from South Frontage Road / Water Street
- Coordination will be required with Metro North Railroad to minimize or avoid outages
- Coordination will be required with the Coast Guard due to work in the navigation channel










Environmental Permits & Requirements

- Project is not expected to result in a Project Scope Change that affects air quality code per ECPPD-2022-1.


