I. APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

By application 2109-TH-80-L filed on September 09, 2021, pursuant to Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.), Helping Hands Transportation, LLC (hereinafter "applicant"), holder of Livery Permit Number 3687, seeks authorization from the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), to transfer its Plainfield headquarters to Norwich, and close the Plainfield headquarters. Specifically, to transfer:

1. Three (3) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service from a headquarters in Plainfield.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A legal notice was mailed to registered livery companies in the headquarters town and towns contiguous to its headquarters town and was not opposed within the thirty (30) days as allowed by statute. The Department's staff has analyzed the evidence presented in this instant application and finds that it should be granted without a hearing.

III. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before this Department.
2. The Department finds that the applicant's records indicate all its vehicles have been in use and are available for transfer.
3. No opposition was filed by existing operators in the headquarters town.

IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-103, the instant application, given Application Number 2109-TH-80-L, filed by Helping Hands Transportation, LLC, is approved and Livery Permit Number 3687 is amended and reissued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3687 **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

Helping Hands Transportation, LLC is hereby permitted and authorized to operate three (3) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Norwich.

This permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of the July 2nd, 2021, at which time the final decision was granted for application 2106-AVWO-52-L. If at any time during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 2106-AVWO-52-L, the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
