## I. INTRODUCTION

Excelsior Trucking, Inc. dba College Hunks Hauling Junk and Moving (hereinafter “transferor”) is the holder of Certificate No. HG1772 last issued by the Department of Transportation (hereinafter “Department”) on June 10, 2013, authorizing, subject to such regulations and conditions as the Department may from time to time prescribe, to transport property for hire as a motor common carrier over irregular routes as follows: Household goods within the State of Connecticut, between all points upon calls received at its headquarters in Stamford.

## II. APPLICANTS' PROPOSAL

By joint application filed on December 22, 2021, given Application No. 2112-S-116-HG, the applicants seek Department approval of the sale and transfer of the authority, granted under Certificate No. HG1772 from the transferor to CHHJ Corporate Stores, LLC (hereinafter “applicant”). CHHJ Corporate Stores, LLC intends to purchase and assume the company name, Excelsior Trucking, Inc. dba College Hunks Hauling Junk and Moving, and Certificate No. HG1772 as part of the sale.

## III. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. After a review of the transferor's records, it was determined that the transferor had bills of lading.
2. The transferee's financial statement indicates it is financially able to staff, equip and operate the household goods moving service transferred herein.
3. The required Connecticut State Police Criminal History Information Report, indicating the absence of any criminal records of the transferee, was filed with the application.
4. A copy of the purchase agreement was submitted with the application.
5. The transferee intends to purchase and assume the company name, Excelsior Trucking, Inc. dba College Hunks Hauling Junk and Moving, and Certificate No. HG1772 as part of this sale.

## IV. CONCLUSION

Therefore, based upon the facts stated above, and pursuant to CGS, Section 13b-406, the Department hereby approves the sale and transfer of the authority granted under Certificate No. HG1772 as proposed, to the transferee, CHHJ Corporate Stores, LLC. Following the approval of this sale and transfer, the transferor will retain no rights to the authority transferred and Certificate No. HG1772 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

Excelsior Trucking, Inc. dba College Hunks Hauling Junk and Moving is hereby permitted and authorized, subject to such regulations and conditions as the Department may from time to time prescribe, to transport property for hire as a motor common carrier over irregular routes as follows:

**Household goods within the State of Connecticut, between all points upon calls received at a headquarters in Stamford.**

The certificate holder must accept and transport property, as herein authorized in accordance with its tariff on file, for all persons who desire the service to the extent of the certificate holder's facilities at uniform rate for all similar service.

There shall be carried in each vehicle operated under this authority a copy of the certificate registration receipt by the Department.

The certificate shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke this certificate.

This certificate may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational for more than twenty-four (24) months. This certificate is transferrable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder thereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe.

A memorandum of this certificate, bearing the seal of the Department, shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicle operated hereunder.
