<u>APPLICATION 2204-RE-35-L</u> <u>RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF</u> <u>MCKEON AND MCKEON INC. dba JOSHUA'S LIMOUSINE SERVICE</u> <u>TO</u> MCKEON AND MCKEON INC. dba JOSHUA'S WORLDWIDE TRANSPORTATION

INTRODUCTION

By application filed on April 5, 2022, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), McKeon and McKeon Inc. dba Joshua's Limousine Service (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to McKeon and McKeon Inc. dba Joshua's Worldwide Transportation. Therefore, Livery Permit Number P-2643 is amended and re-issued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NO. 2643 FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

McKeon and McKeon Inc. dba Joshua's Worldwide Transportation is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, to operate the following:

- 1. Eighteen (18) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Gales Ferry (Ledyard).
- 2. Four (4) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Stonington.
- 3. Five (5) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Clinton.
- 4. Motor vehicles in interstate and intrastate charter bus service in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-94a.

In addition, McKeon and McKeon, Inc. dba Joshua's Worldwide Transportation is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-287919.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
