I. INTRODUCTION

By application filed on May 25, 2022 with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), pursuant to Section 13b-97(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Section 13b-96-8 of the Connecticut State Agency Regulations, as amended, AB Cab, LLP (hereinafter "applicant") seeks authorization to operate one (1) additional motor vehicle in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Version, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Cromwell, Glastonbury, Middletown and Portland to all points in Connecticut. The applicant, holder of Certificate Number 1024, is currently authorized to operate three (3) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Hartford, East Hartford, East Windsor, Version, West Hartford, East Windsor, Version, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Version, West Hartford, East Windsor, Version, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Version, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Cromwell, Glastonbury, Middletown and Portland to all points in Connecticut.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

- 1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before the Department.
- 2. The applicant has held Certificate Number 1024 for at least one year.
- 3. The Department records indicate that all the existing plates held by the applicant are registered and in use.
- 4. The Department records further indicate that there are no outstanding violations or matters pending adjudication against the applicant.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-97(a), the instant application given Application Number 2205-EXP-59-T is hereby approved and therefore Certificate Number 1024 is hereby amended and reissued as follows:

CERTIFICATE NUMBER 1024 FOR THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES IN TAXICAB SERVICE

AB Cab, LLP is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, to operate a total of Four (4) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Version, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Cromwell, Glastonbury, Middletown and Portland to all points in Connecticut.

The authority granted in application 2205-EXP-59-T may not be sold or transferred until it has been in operation, i.e., a vehicle registered with taxicab plates thereunder, for no less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months. If during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for the full sale or transfer of any of the vehicles authorized herein, the authority granted in application 2205-EXP-59-T will be revoked.

This certificate shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other state statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder hereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations, and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of this certificate, bearing the seal of the Department, shall be kept conspicuously posted in each motor vehicle operated under this certificate.
