APPLICATION 2205-RE-55-L RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF AUTUMN TRANSPORTATION, INC.

<u>TO</u> <u>LUXE AMBASSADOR TRANSPORTATION OF HARTFORD, INC.</u> <u>REVISION AND REISSUANCE</u>

INTRODUCTION

By application filed on May 24, 2022, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Autumn Transportation, Inc. (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to Luxe Ambassador Transportation of Hartford, Inc. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 3724 is amended and reissued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT 3724

Luxe Ambassador Transportation of Hartford, Inc. is authorized to operate Five (5) motor vehicles in general livery service, with a seating capacity of less than eleven passengers, from a headquarters in Rocky Hill.

RESTRICTIONS

Luxe Ambassador Transportation of Hartford, Inc. is only permitted to the use their complete legal company name, Luxe Ambassador Transportation of Hartford, Inc., in any digital or print advertising, and they are prohibited from using a shortened version of their name, including in a website address.

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months from the date of this final decision. If at any time during the twenty-four (24-month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 2203-AVWO-27-L, the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke said permit. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within ninety (90) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicle operated hereunder.
