## APPLICATION NUMBER 2208-N-84-B APPLICATION FOR THE OPERATION OF BUS TYPE MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTRASTATE CHARTER BUS TRANSPORTATION

## **INTRODUCTION**

By application filed on August 25, 2022, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "department"), pursuant to Section 13b-94a of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, Executive Express Charter, LLC (hereinafter "applicant") with a mailing address of 540 E. Main Street, Unit 6, Branford, CT 06405, seeks approval to operate bus type motor vehicles in intrastate charter bus transportation between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Branford.

Executive Express Charter, LLC is currently permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers in charter bus operations in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate No. MC-1454472-C

After consideration by the department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-94a, and bus permit number 584 is amended and re-issued to Executive Express Charter, LLC in the following form:

## BUS PERMIT NUMBER 584 FOR THE OPERATION OF BUS TYPE MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTRASTATE AND INTERSTATE CHARTER BUS TRANSPORTATION

Executive Express Charter, LLC is permitted and authorized to operate bus type motor vehicles in intrastate charter bus transportation in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-94a, from a headquarters in Branford.

In addition, pursuant to Sections 13b-88 and 13b-99 of the Connecticut General Statutes, Executive Express Charter, LLC is permitted and authorized to operate bus type motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers in charter bus operations in interstate commerce, under such authorization as issued, or amended, by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in issuance of Certificate Number MC-1454472-C.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the department. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this Decision.
