## APPLICATION 2212-RE-125-L RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF DWIGHT HALL DBA JUNIORS WAY TRANSPORT TO JUNIORS WAY TRANSPORT LLC

## INTRODUCTION

By application filed on December 6, 2022, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Dwight Hall dba Juniors Way Transport (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled his authority to Juniors Way Transport, LLC. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 3747 is amended and re-issued as follows:

## **LIVERY PERMIT 3747**

Juniors Way Transport, LLC is authorized to operate ONE (1) motor vehicle in general livery service, with a seating capacity of less than eleven passengers, from a headquarters in Hamden.

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke said permit. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within ninety (90) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicle operated hereunder.
