REVISION AND REISSUANCE

9207-I-46-L (GRANTED ON JULY 30, 1992) <u>COLLINS BUS SERVICE, INC.</u> PERMIT # 347

INTRODUCTION

As a result of meeting with Thomas Snow, Secretary of Collins Bus Service, Inc., on April 12, 2022, it was brought to the Department's attention that Collins Bus Service, Inc. had activated a new Motor Carrier Number, MC-89433-C and were no longer using the old, inactive Motor Carrier Number, MC-244750-C.

Therefore, Livery Permit 347 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 347 FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Collins Bus Service, Inc. is hereby permitted and authorized to operate bus type motor vehicles in general livery service from a headquarters in South Windsor.

Collins Bus Service, Inc. is further permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-89433-C.

This permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of this final decision. If at any time during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 9207-I-46-L (granted on July 30, 1992), the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
