





Introduction

Yellow Green





Color by number


- 1. Red

PUSH BUTTON FOR WALK SIGNAL


Push the button once, and wait for the walk symbol.




It's okay to walk when this symbol is white. Remember, look both ways to see if the street is safe to cross.



Don't walk if the hand is RED.










Below is the shape of a street name sign.

Make it look like your street name sign.


