The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of the project is to address the structural deficiencies of the bridge to accommodate safe travel for all users and proper conveyance of the brook water below.

Right-of-way impacts are expected consisting of partial takes, slope easements, drainage rights of way, temporary construction easements and rights.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2027. The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$3.2 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
