The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This meeting is to present the additional Complete Streets elements being introduced to the project that will ensure safe travel for pedestrians and bicyclists on Route 10 between the Talcott Notch Road and Old Farms Road intersections.

Right-of-way impacts are associated with the proposed improvements including partial takes, slope easements, drainage rights of way and temporary construction easements.

Construction is expected to start in 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits.

The estimated cost is \$7 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
