The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The project involves replacing the aging traffic signal infrastructure at intersections along the route by installing new traffic signal equipment and replacing the existing signal system.

There is potential for right-of-way impacts around new signal equipment and newly installed sidewalks at some project intersections. There will be newly installed sidewalk at some project locations.

Construction is expected to start fall 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$14 million, with 80% federal and 20% state funds.
