The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and provide comments concerning the proposed improvements.

The purpose of the project is to reduce flooding along Route 42, particularly in the vicinity of 372 North Brooksvale Road and the Long Hill Road and Avon Boulevard intersections by increasing the capacity of the stormwater drainage system.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements which include temporary construction easements, drainage easements, and partial property acquisitions for the reconstruction of sidewalks.

Construction is expected to start spring 2028 subject to available funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$5 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.

The public can submit comments and questions during the two-week public comment period following the meeting.
